AFT St. Louis to Host Free Vaccine Clinic for St. Louis Public School Staff, Students and General Public

Oct. 10 at St. Louis Artworks

ST. LOUIS—AFT St. Louis, Local 420, is hosting a free vaccine clinic on Sunday, Oct. 10, for St. Louis Public School staff, students and the general public, noting that all SLPS staff must be vaccinated by Oct. 15.

"This vaccine clinic will have a carnival atmosphere with a very serious mission—to get school staff, eligible students and members of the general public vaccinated," said AFT St. Louis President Ray Cummings. "We waited a long time for our schools to be fully open; now we want them to stay that way with everyone properly protected."

The vaccines will be administered by the St. Louis Health Department. Attendees will have a chance to win \$100 gift cards, and there will be games for kids and giveaways, such as school supplies, masks and other PPE. Music will be supplied by Deevine Soundz.

In addition to AFT St. Louis, other groups involved in the clinic include GOTVax and STLVax, ServiceMaster Clean and St. Louis Artworks.
